Forrest Bird invented ventilators - Pronounced as **VEN-TI-LAY-TOR**. Ventilators provide oxygen to the lungs to help an individual breathe.

Do you know why we have covered ventilators in this issue ? It's because the most difficult symptom of the coronavirus is breathlessness and ventilators help manage that.

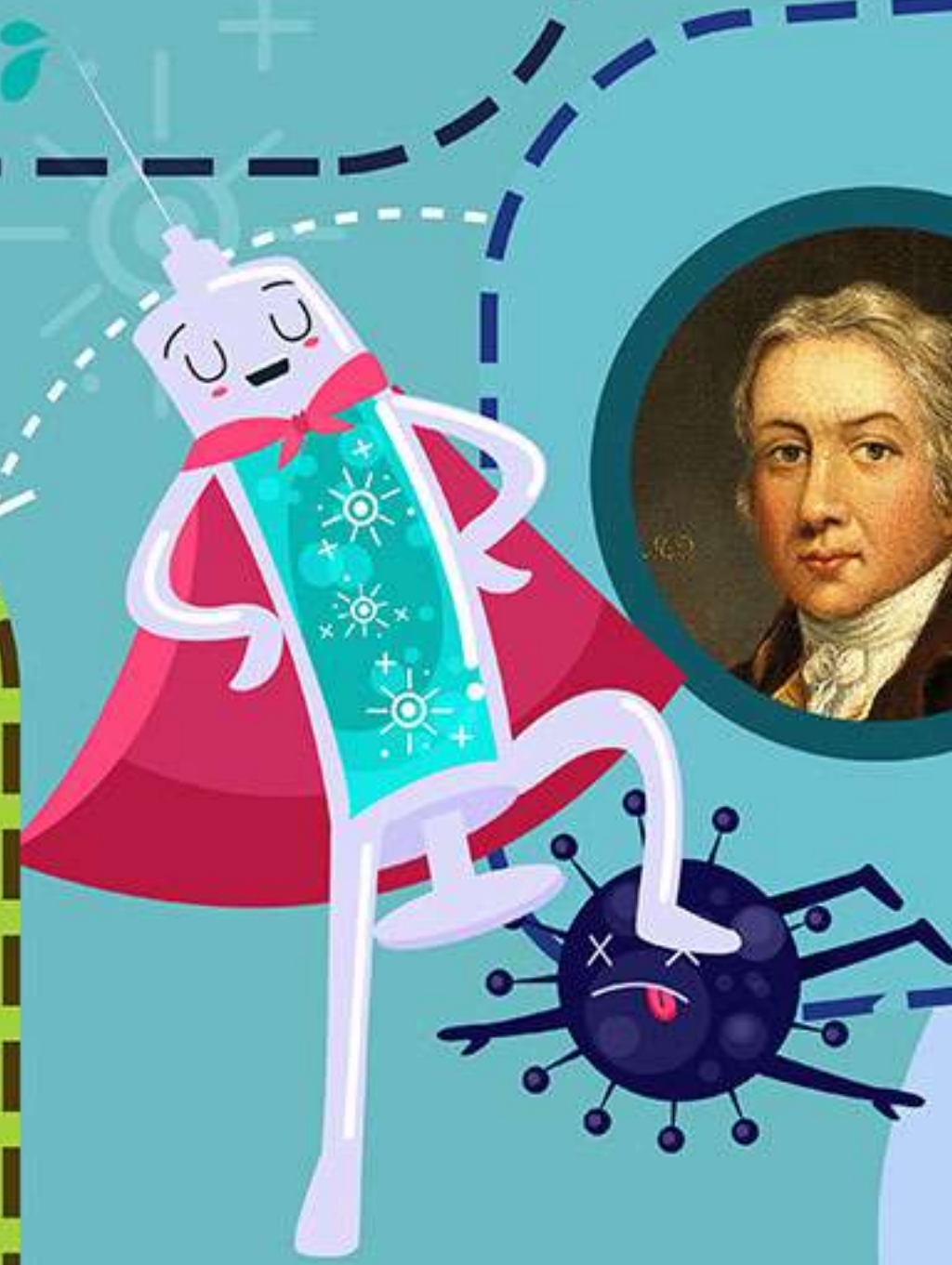


What inspired him to think of something so useful ? Jenner invented it as a treatment for smallpox and cowpox which was rampant in the 19th century.

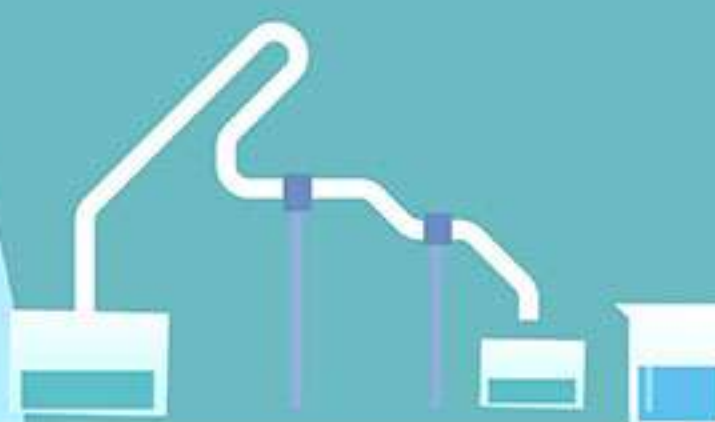
(Any ideas as to what the word rampant may mean ? It means something that is unwelcome and spreads easily. It is pronounced as RAM-PUNT.)

Currently scientists haven't yet found a vaccine for the coronavirus, thus the safest thing to do is stay at home and do the fun activities in this paper.



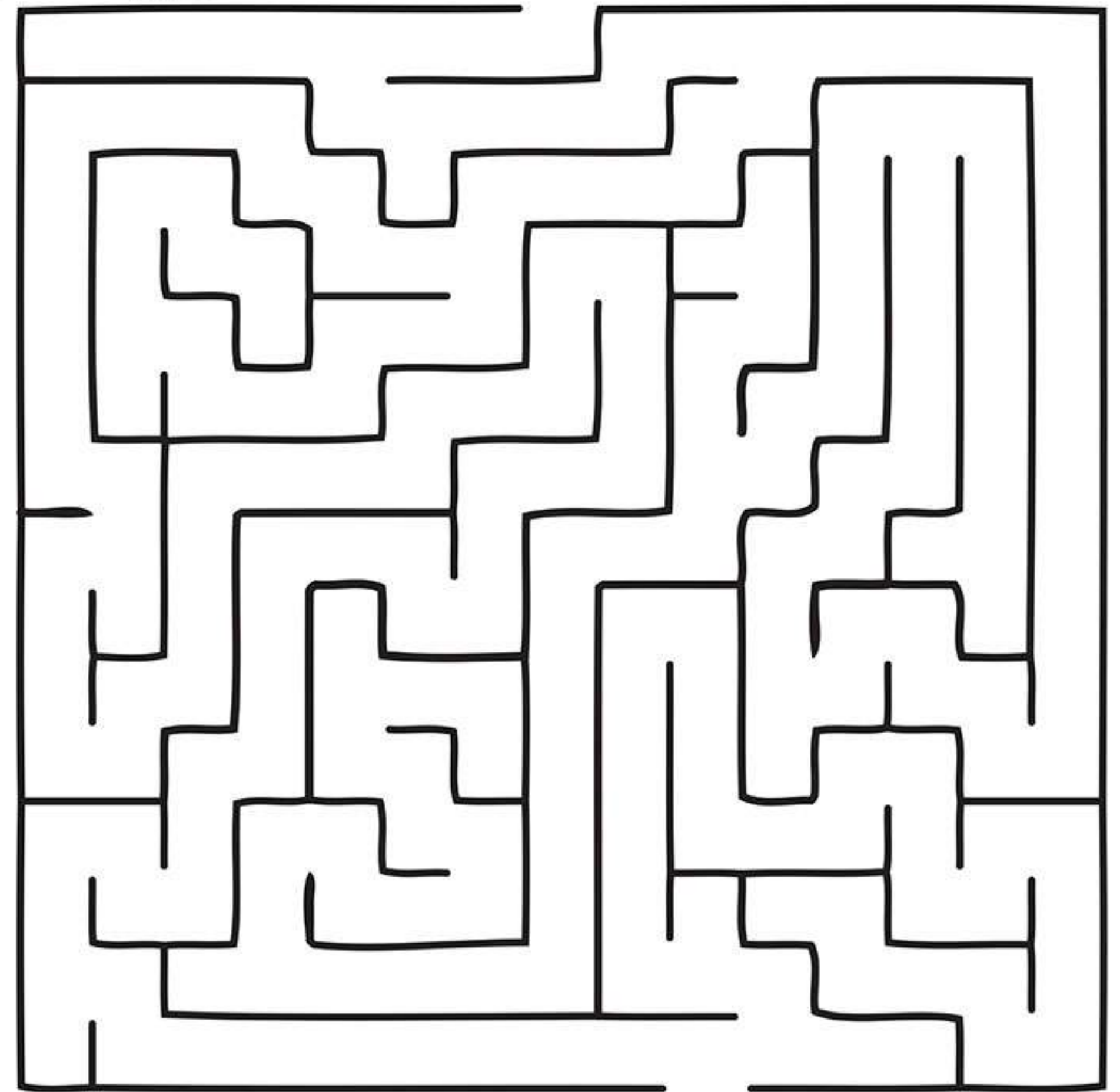
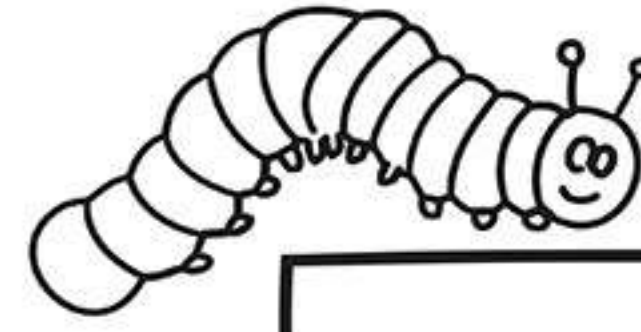

- 2 tablespoons of cinnamon sugar
- 2 tablespoons sugar

- Paper bowls
- White Woolen String
- Glow-in-the-dark acrylic paint
- Paint brushes
- Scissors
- Zip lock bags
- Sharp pencil

METHOD

Paint the paper bowls with the glow in the dark acrylic colours. Set to dry

Cut the wool into strips, put them in a ziplock bag, add paint and squish, squish, squish.

Take the bowl and make a hole in the bottom with your sharpened pencil.

Take a strip and thread it through.

Thread in the rest of the strips and turn it over

Voila your paper plate jellyfish are ready. You can hang them in your room.

It is not really a surprise that there are no trees or shrubs found in the Antarctic, but the amazing fact is, the species that do grow there are two flowering plants.

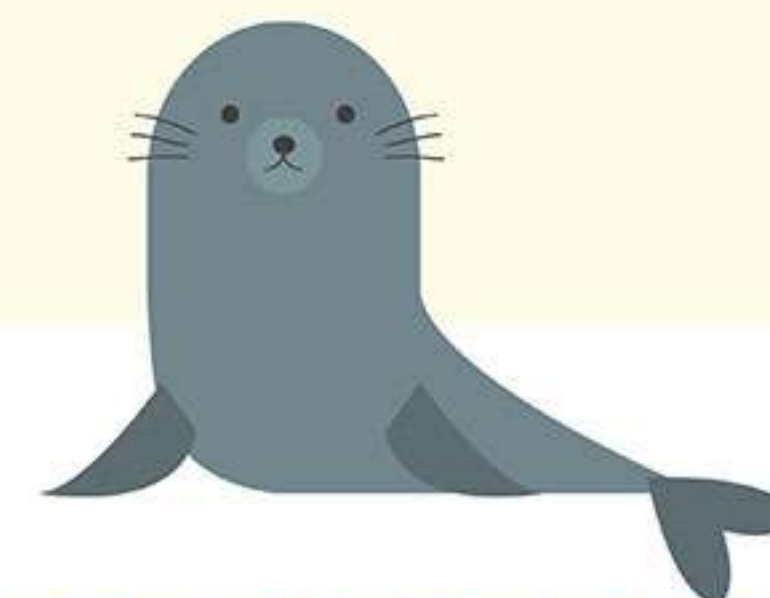
ICY DESERT PLANTS - BRRRR COLD



The Hair Grass has long slender leaves and can survive freezing temperatures without dying. The Pearlwort has a very soft appearance and can grow upto the really tiny height of 5cms.

The most common animal found in the antarctic are seals and the most common birds are cute penguins and the albatross.



THE SAND CAT



Did you know

- An area doesn't need to be hot to be known as a desert? The world's largest desert is Antarctica
- There are parts in Atacama Desert in Chile where no rain has ever been recorded.

The sand cat is one of the only species of cat to inhabit the deserts exclusively (Pronounced as: EX-CLU-SIV-LEE which means special). The sand cat is listed as threatened, which means that if we don't take enough care of them there will be very few left. The colouring on the sand cat acts as a camouflage (Pronounced as: CA as in CAN - MO and FLAJ which means that they aren't easy to spot).



Fun Facts about Sand Cat

- 01 These furballs are the only cats that can bark like dogs.
- 02 Sand cats have long bushy tails that are 9-12 inches long!
- 03 They have furry paws which not only protect their feet from the hot desert sand but also don't leave foot prints thus saving them from predators.

There are many more awesome facts about Antarctica, but what you would most likely not believe is this freezing desert has **ACTIVE VOLCANOES**. Mt. Erebus is an icelocked volcano in Antarctica, it has unique features such as ice fumaroles (frozen clouds of smoke) and natural ice statues. You can try freezing some bubbles. That would look really cool

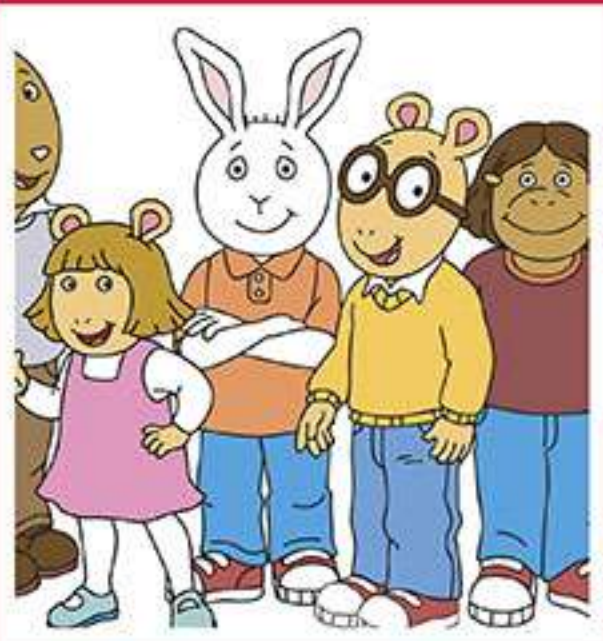
The Odd Squad -

Quidditch - As you would expect from the name the players are indeed mounted on brooms or PVC pipes if brooms are not available.

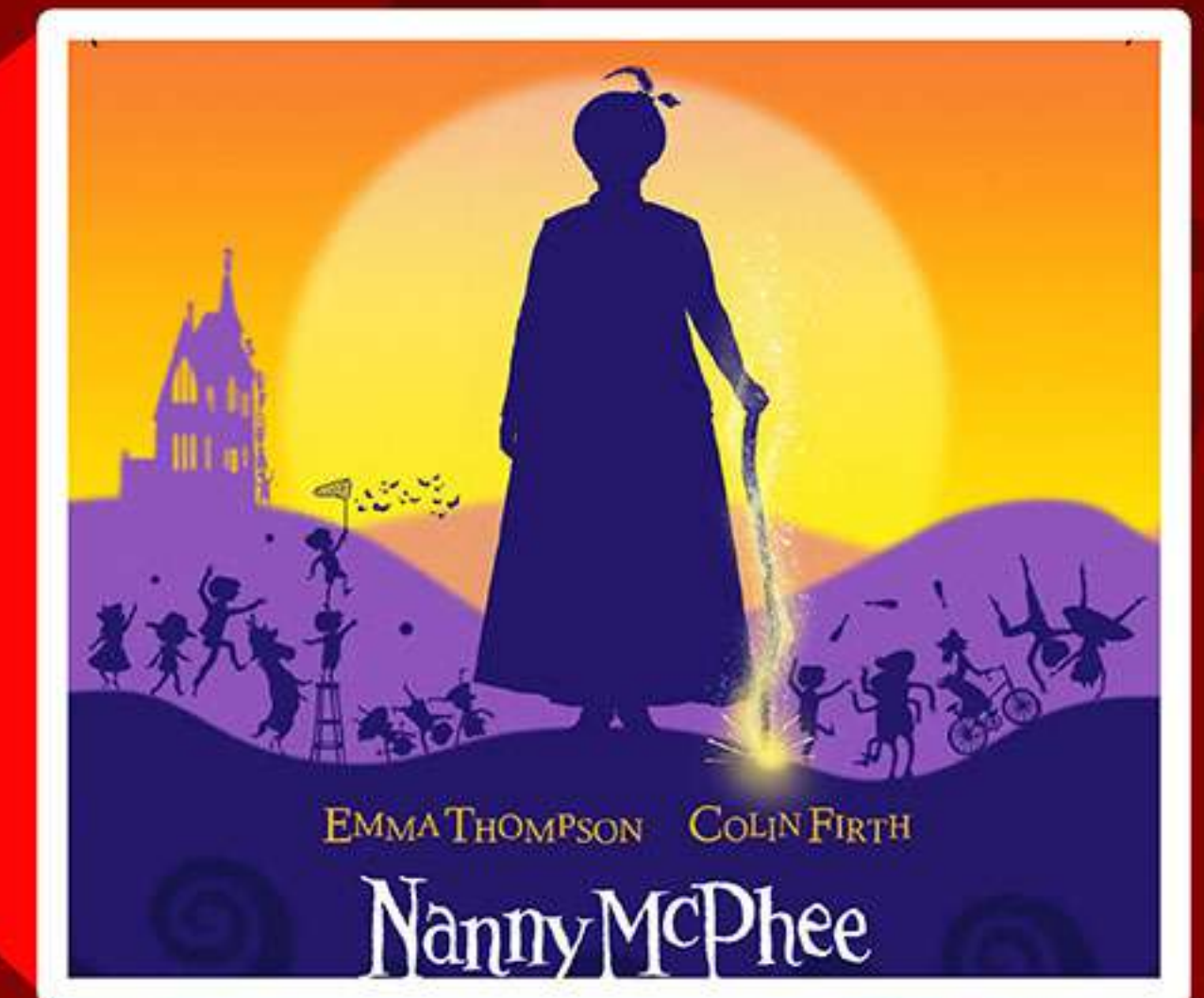
The game is played in Canada. Canadian Quidditch is played on a ground which is the size of a hockey field.
