4. Wear a medical mask in very crowded places.

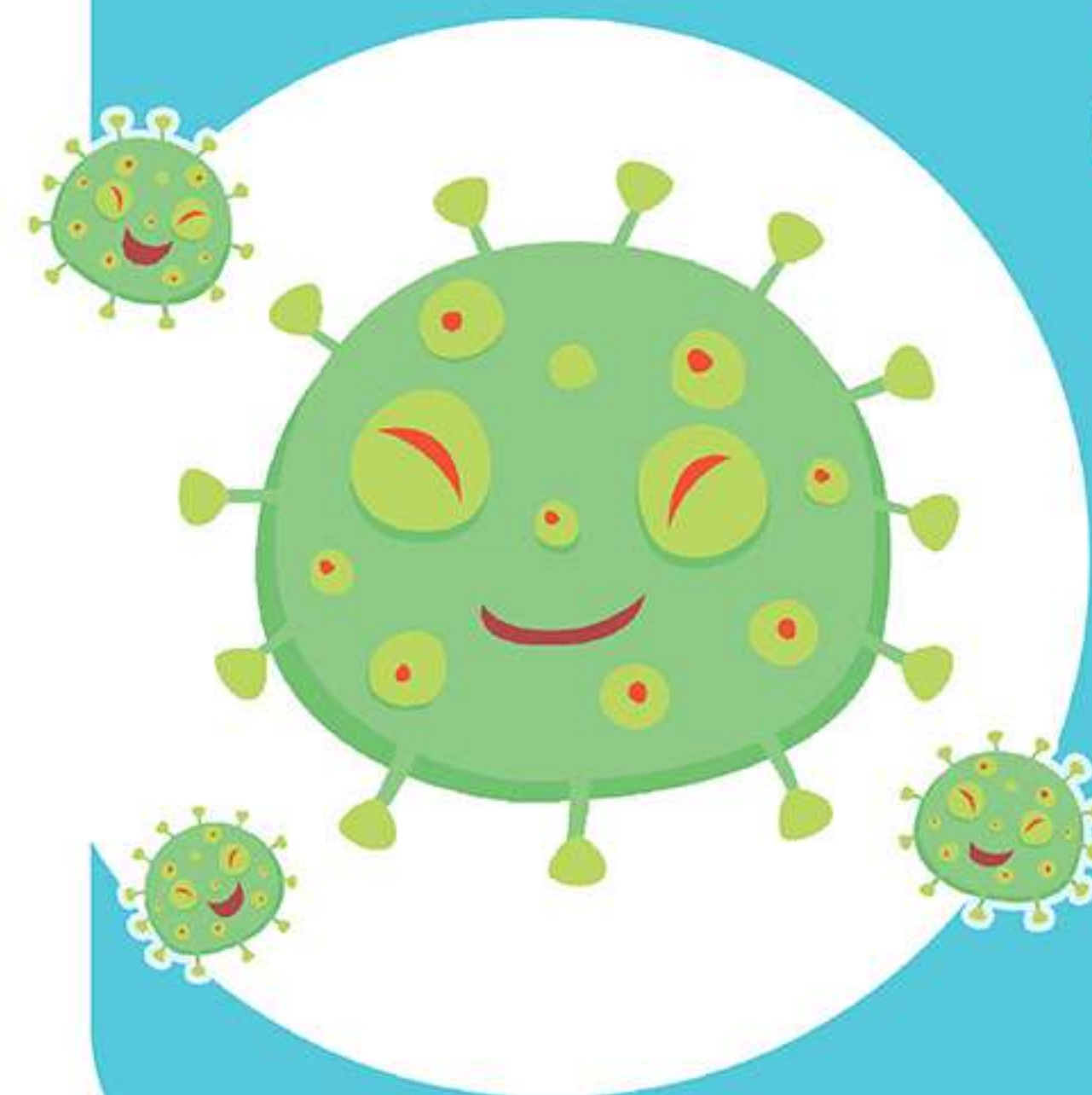


5. Avoid contact with a sick person.

- Viruses like the flu can live 24 hours or longer on canteen tables, doorknobs and cups.



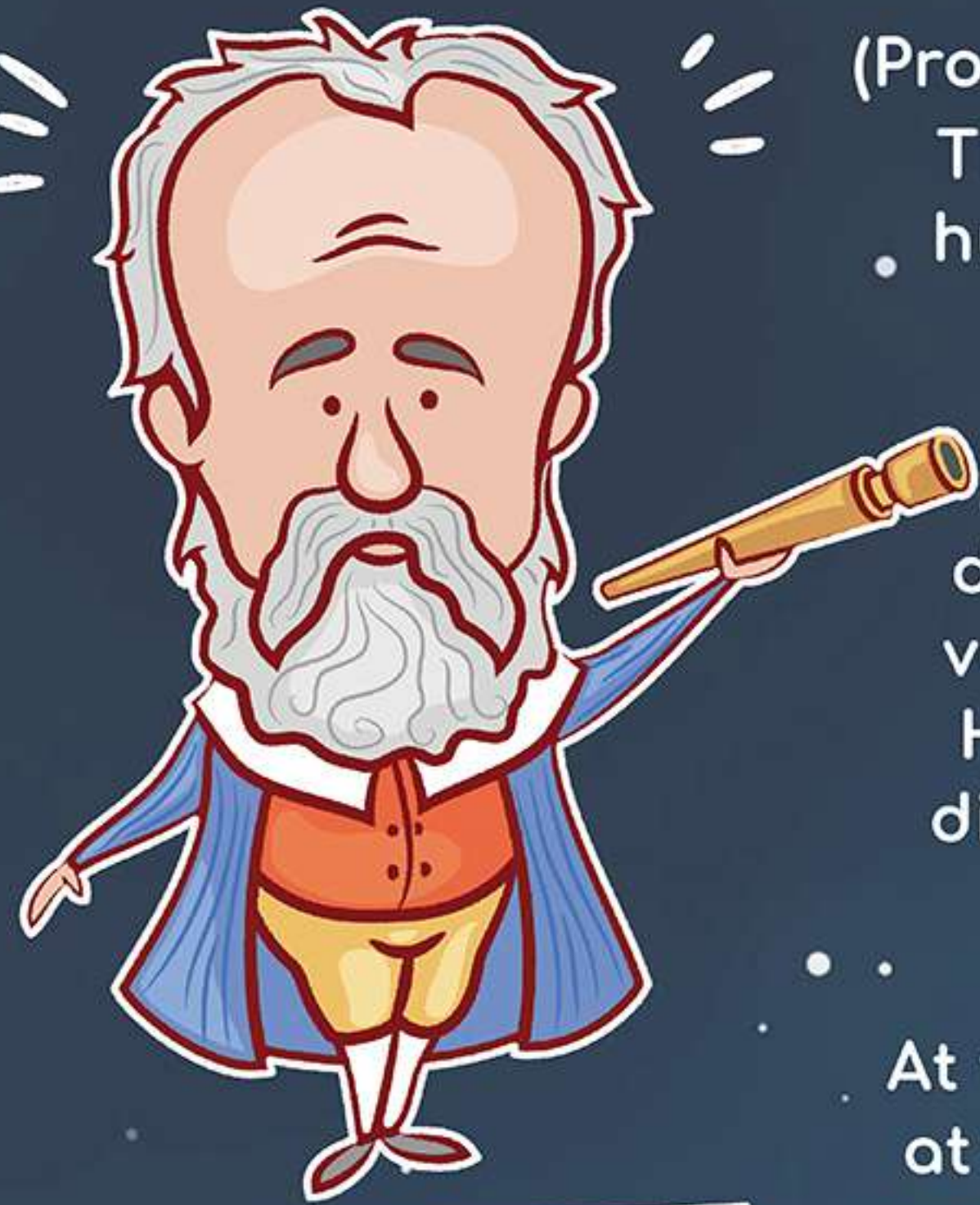

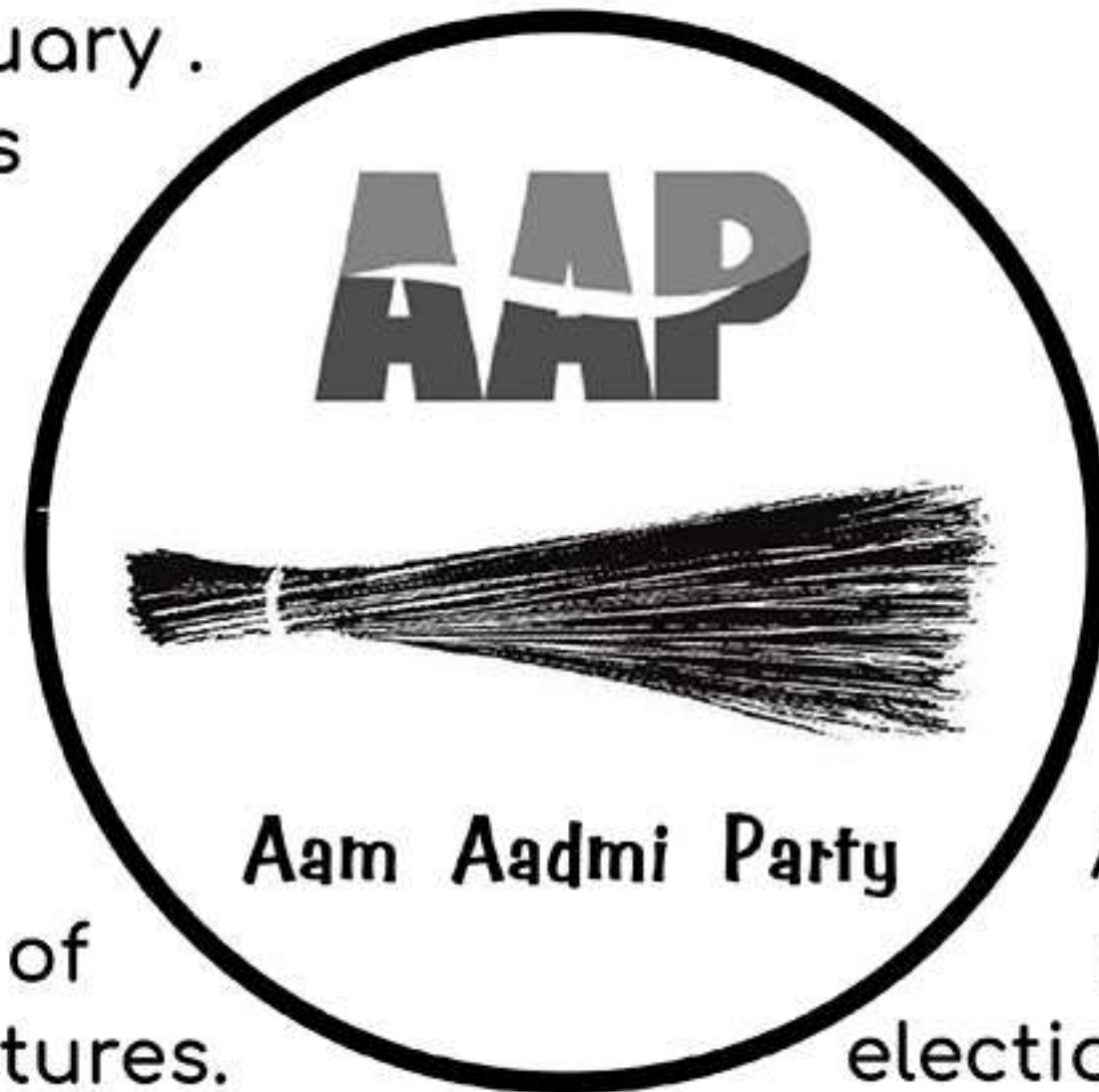


DELHI HAS A NEW CHIEF MINISTER - ARVIND KEJRIWAAL

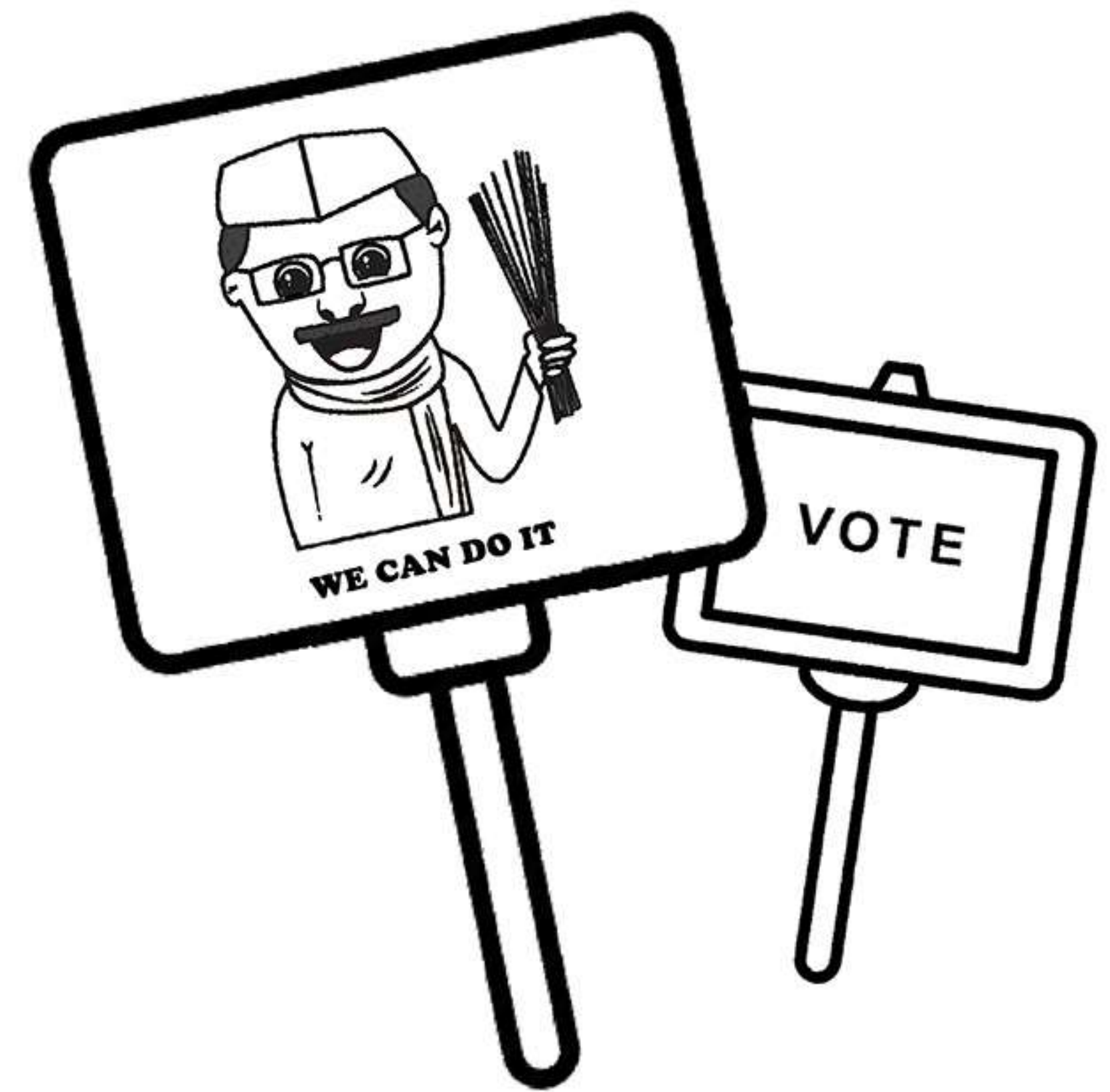
WHAT IS A CHIEF MINISTER ?

The person who runs the state is the Chief Minister.

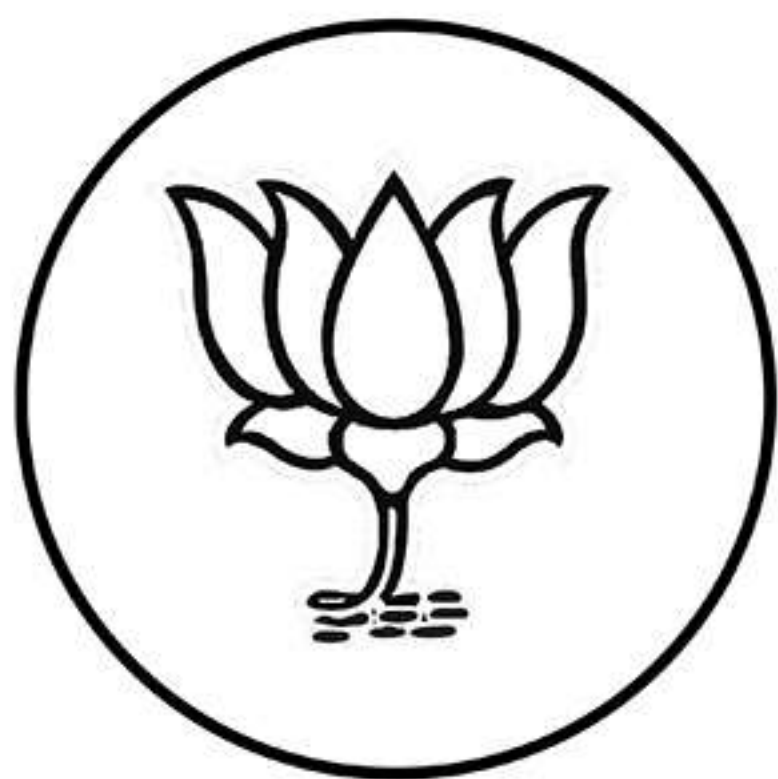

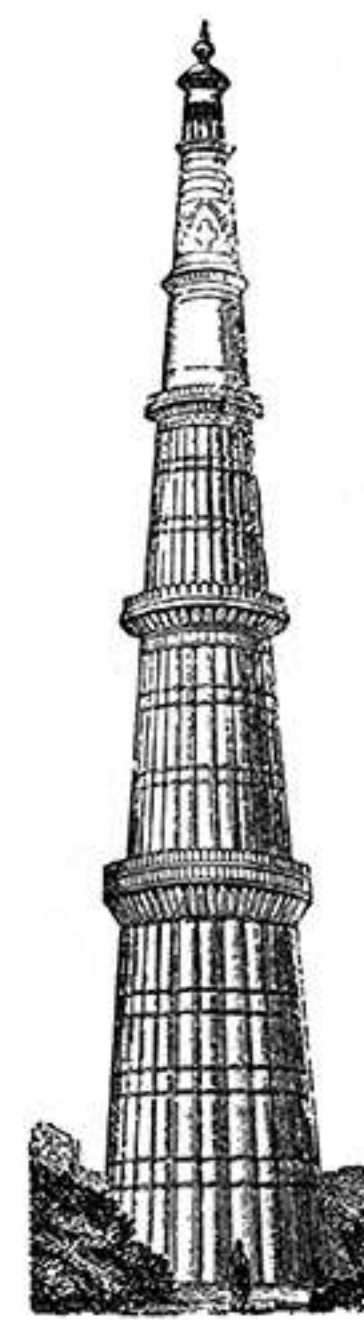


TRUMP COMES TO INDIA

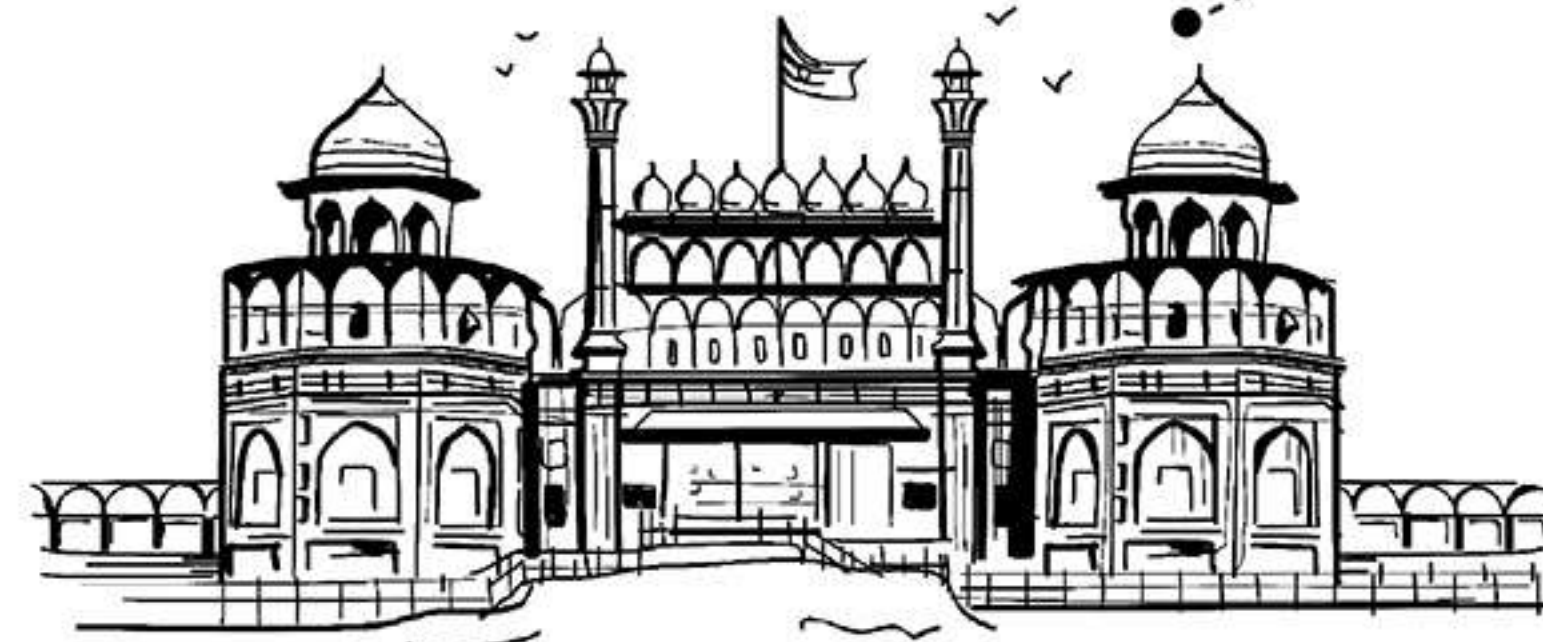
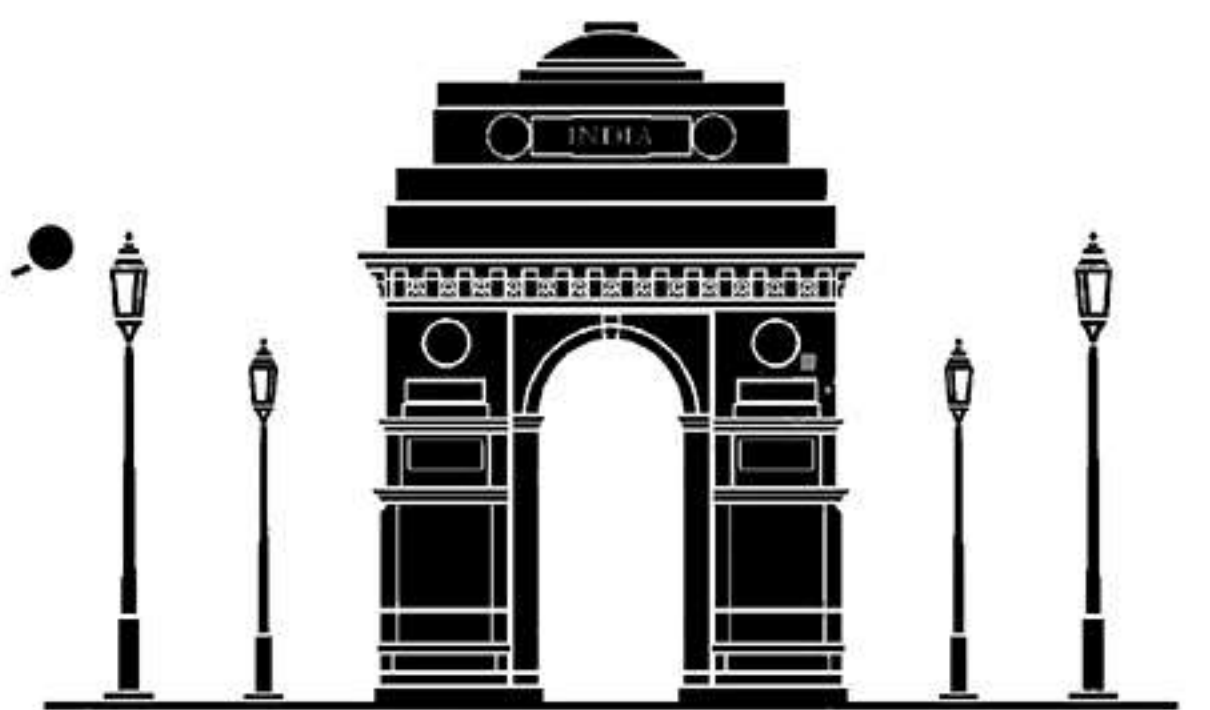


If you had a day to spend in Delhi, what would you do?



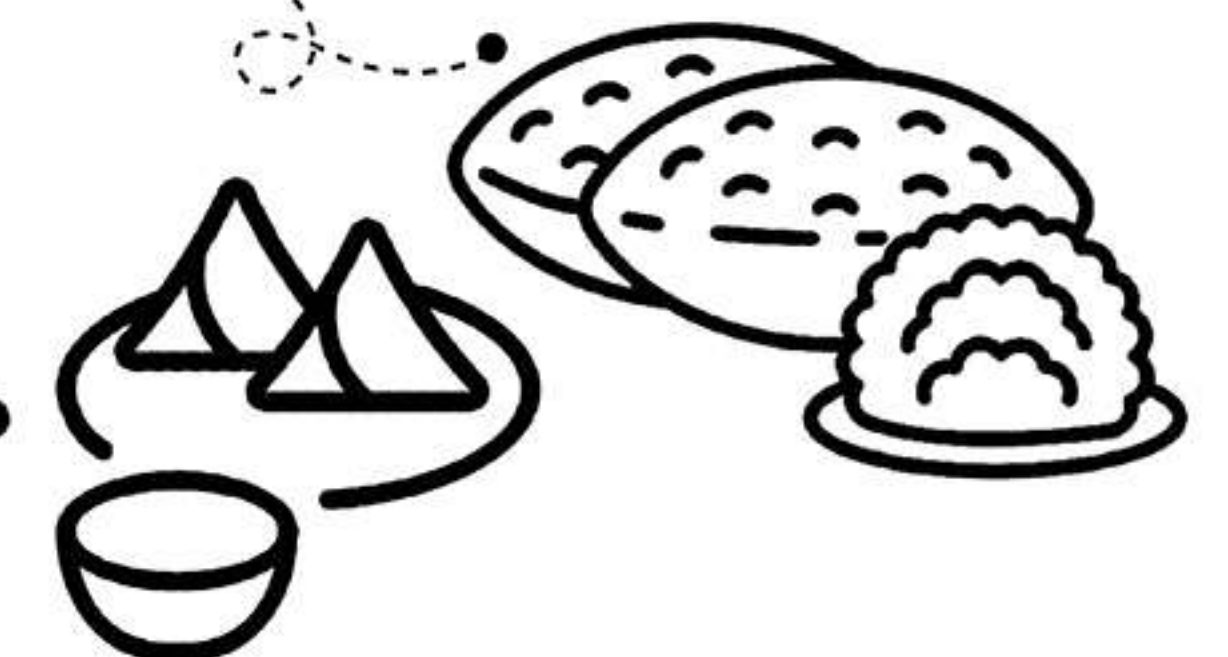
I would visit the _____

Then I would go to Paranthi Wali Galli. I will eat Chaat, Kebabs, Jalebi, Lassi ... Yummy!



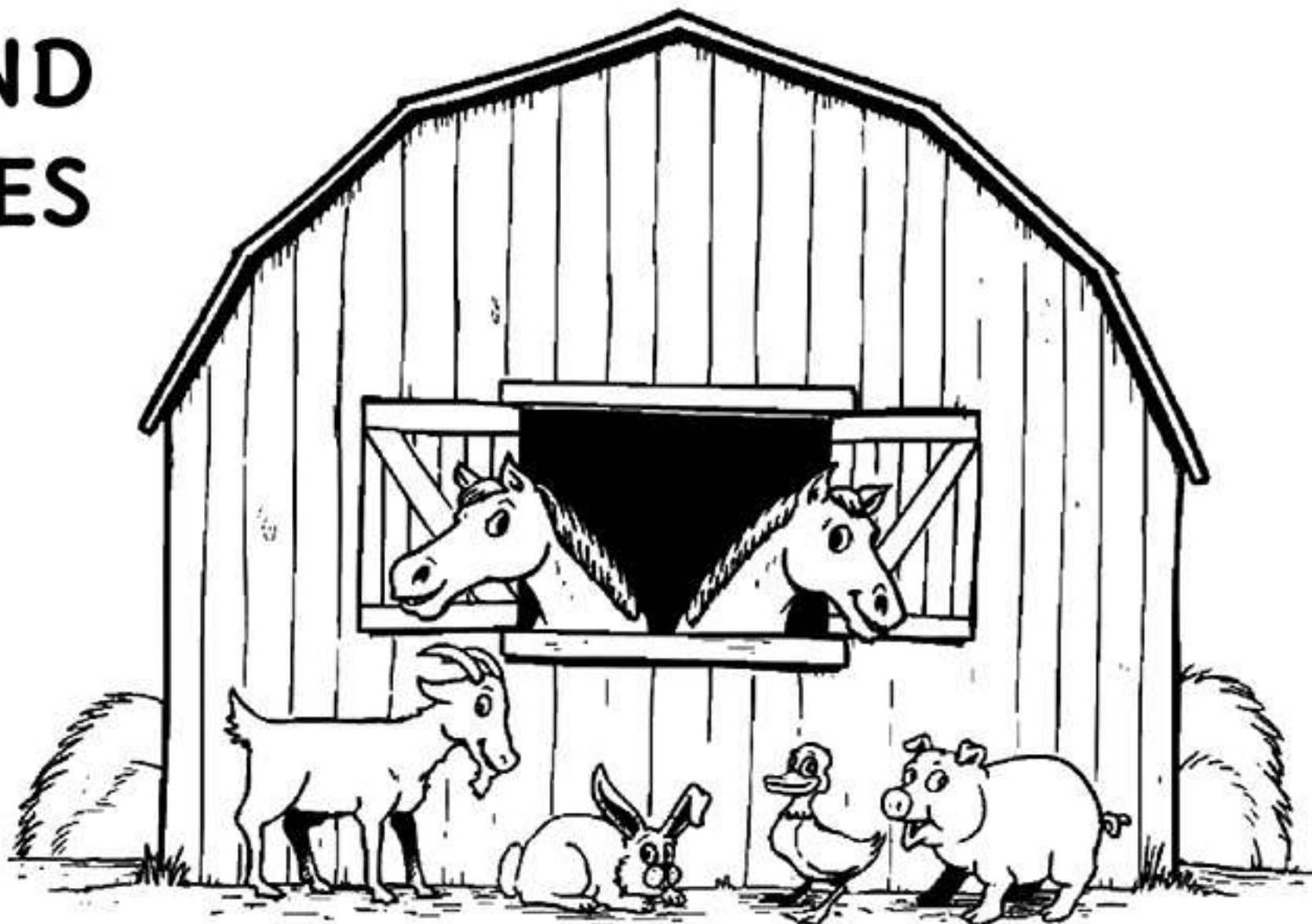
In the evening I would go to Connaught Place, which has lots of yummy places like Nirulas where you get chocolate fudge!!

One day is too little time to see a great city like New Delhi.

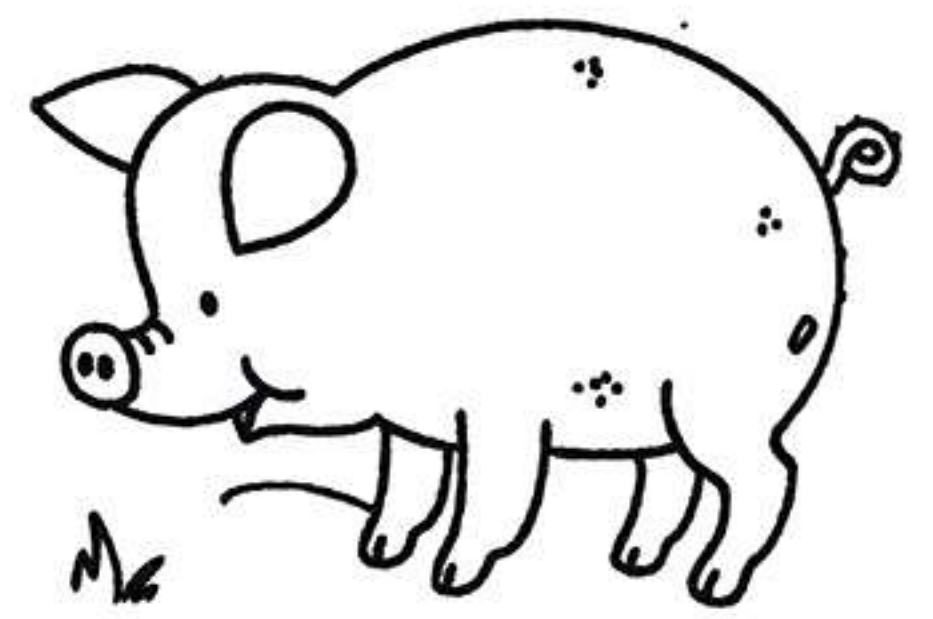

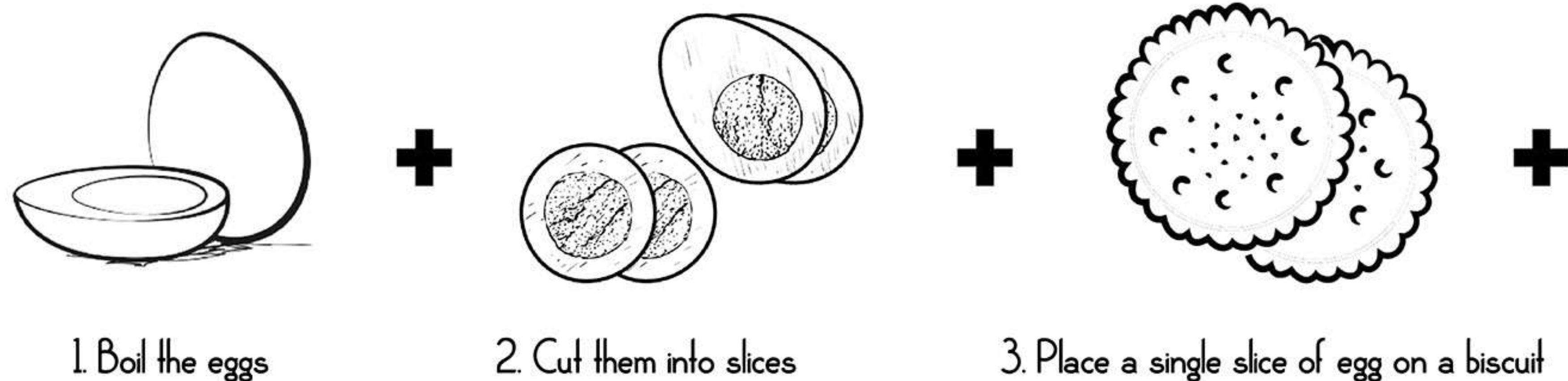

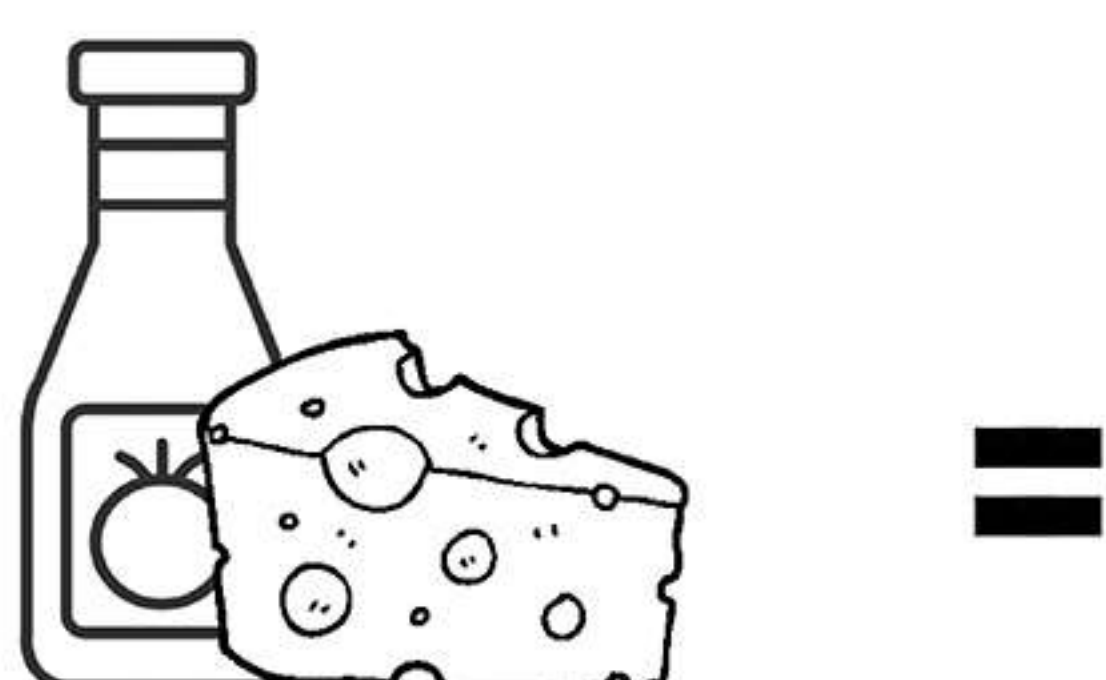
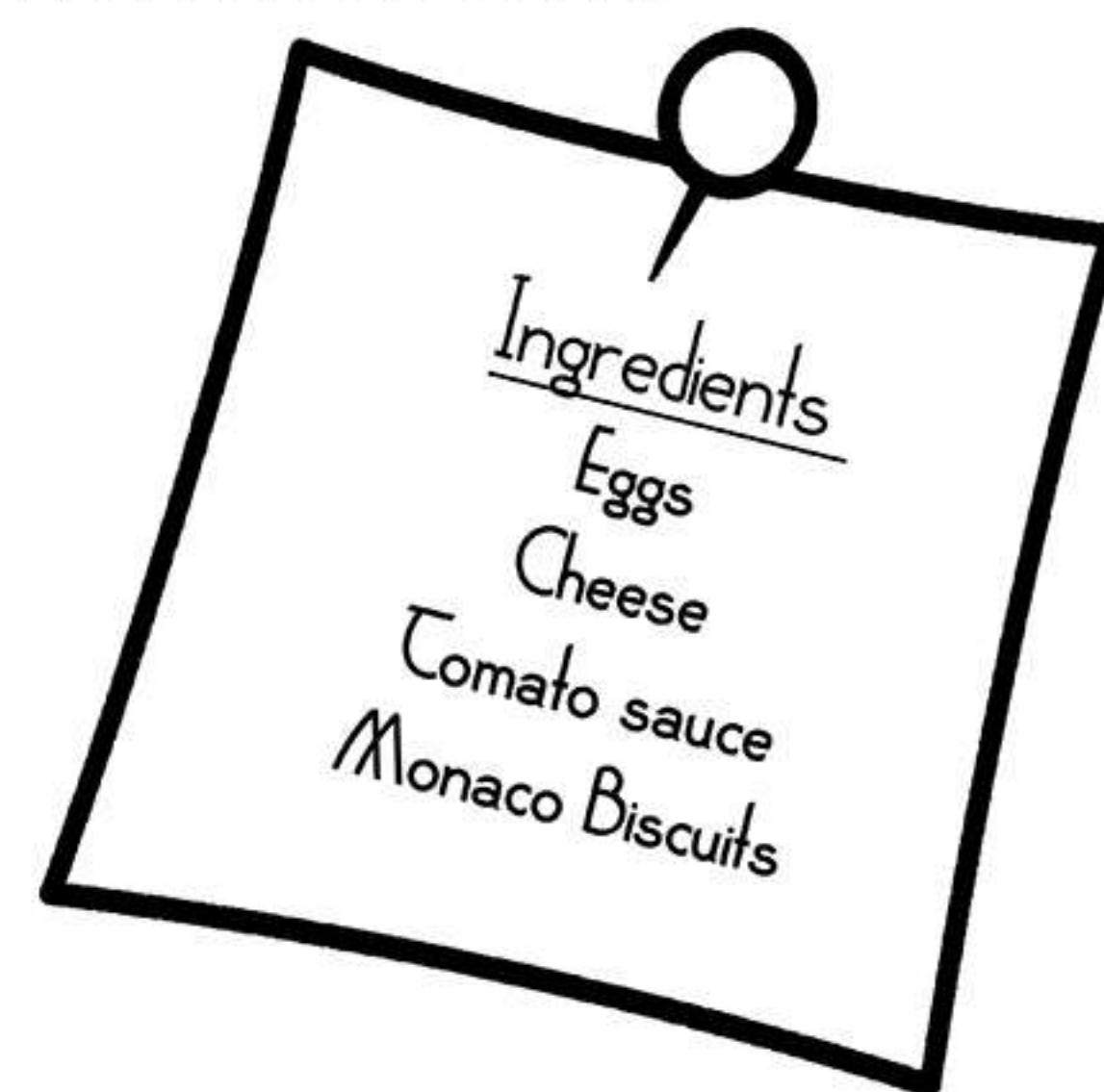
MONACO, CHEESE AND EGG BITES

2. Cut them into slices

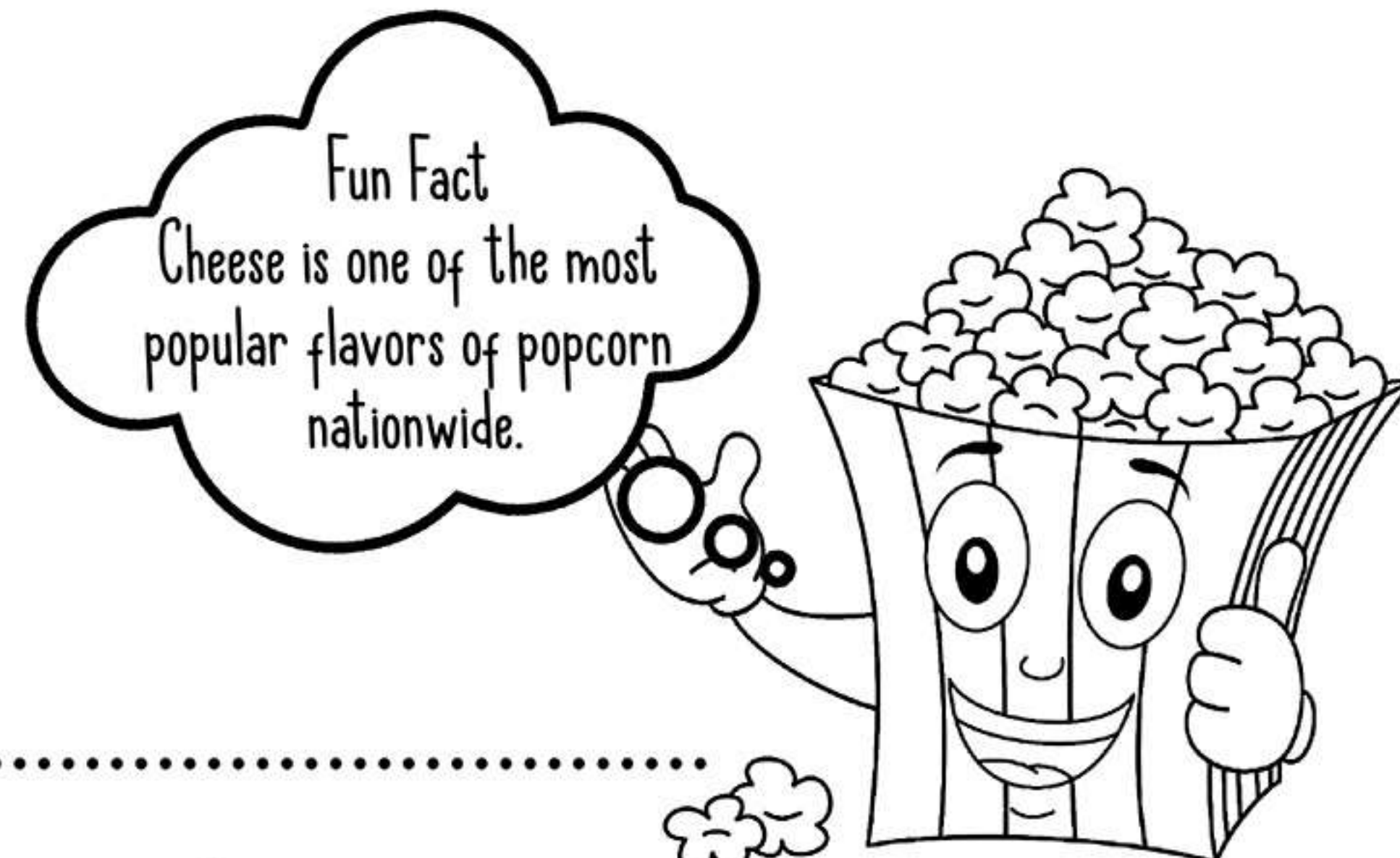
3. Place a single slice of egg on a biscuit



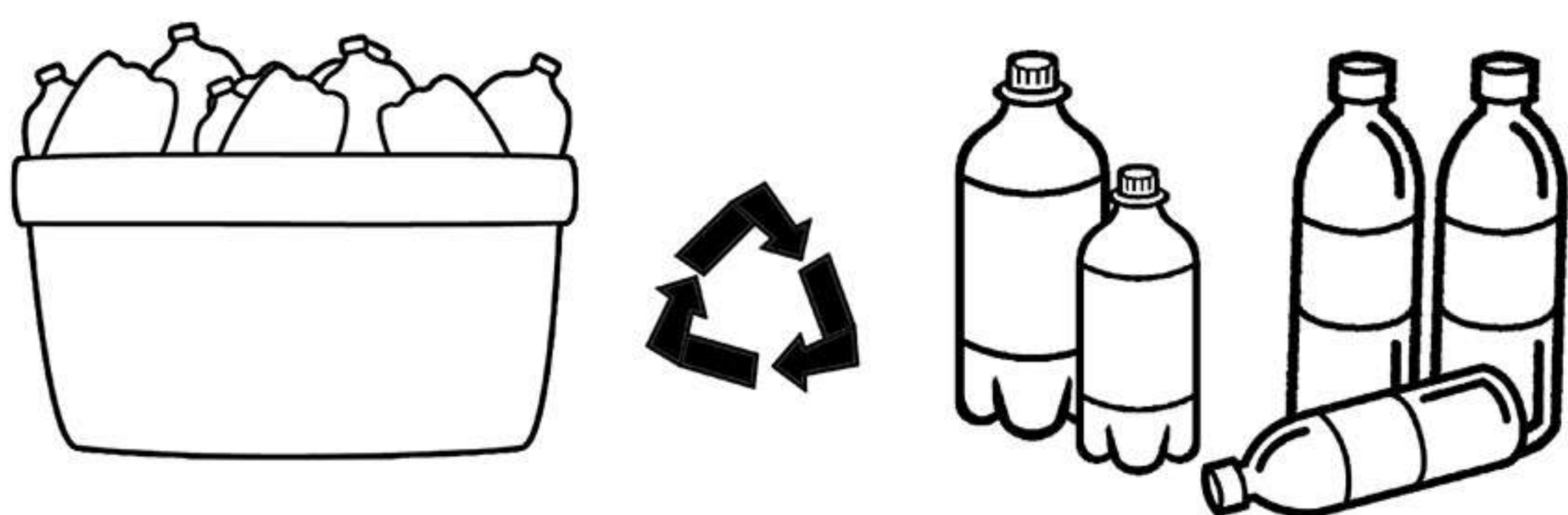

FRIENDLY FACE BOTTLE PLANTER



STEP 1

Cut out the bottom of a large plastic bottle. With a small scissor, make 2-3 holes at the base of the bottle. This will help to drain extra water.

STEP 2

Stick the eyes and nose to the plastic bottle. You can use the cap of the bottle as the nose. Use little bits of cardboard for the eyes.

STEP 3

Fill the containers with soil almost to the top-leave a little bit at the top.



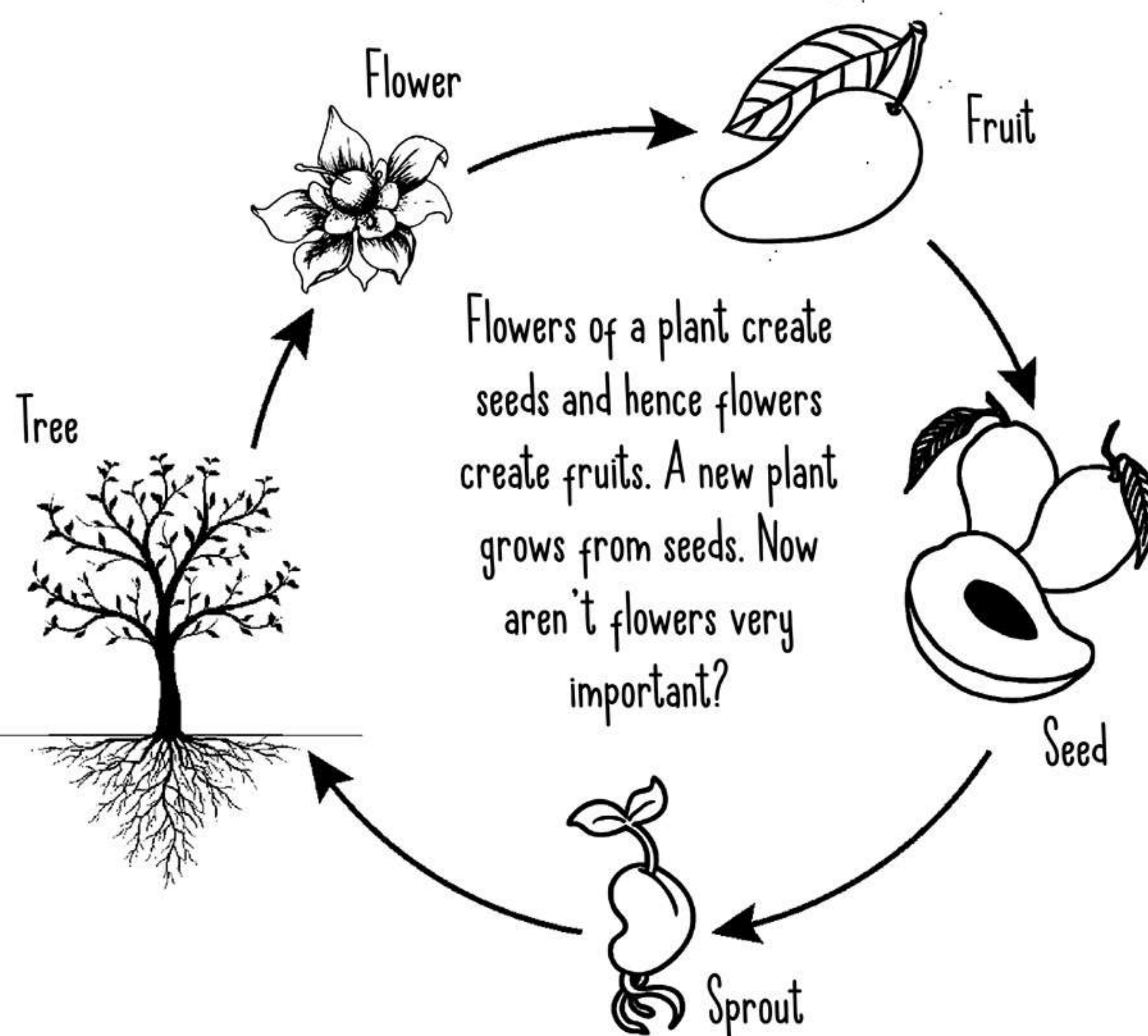
STEP 4

Cover with a layer of any seeds you like and cover with more soil.

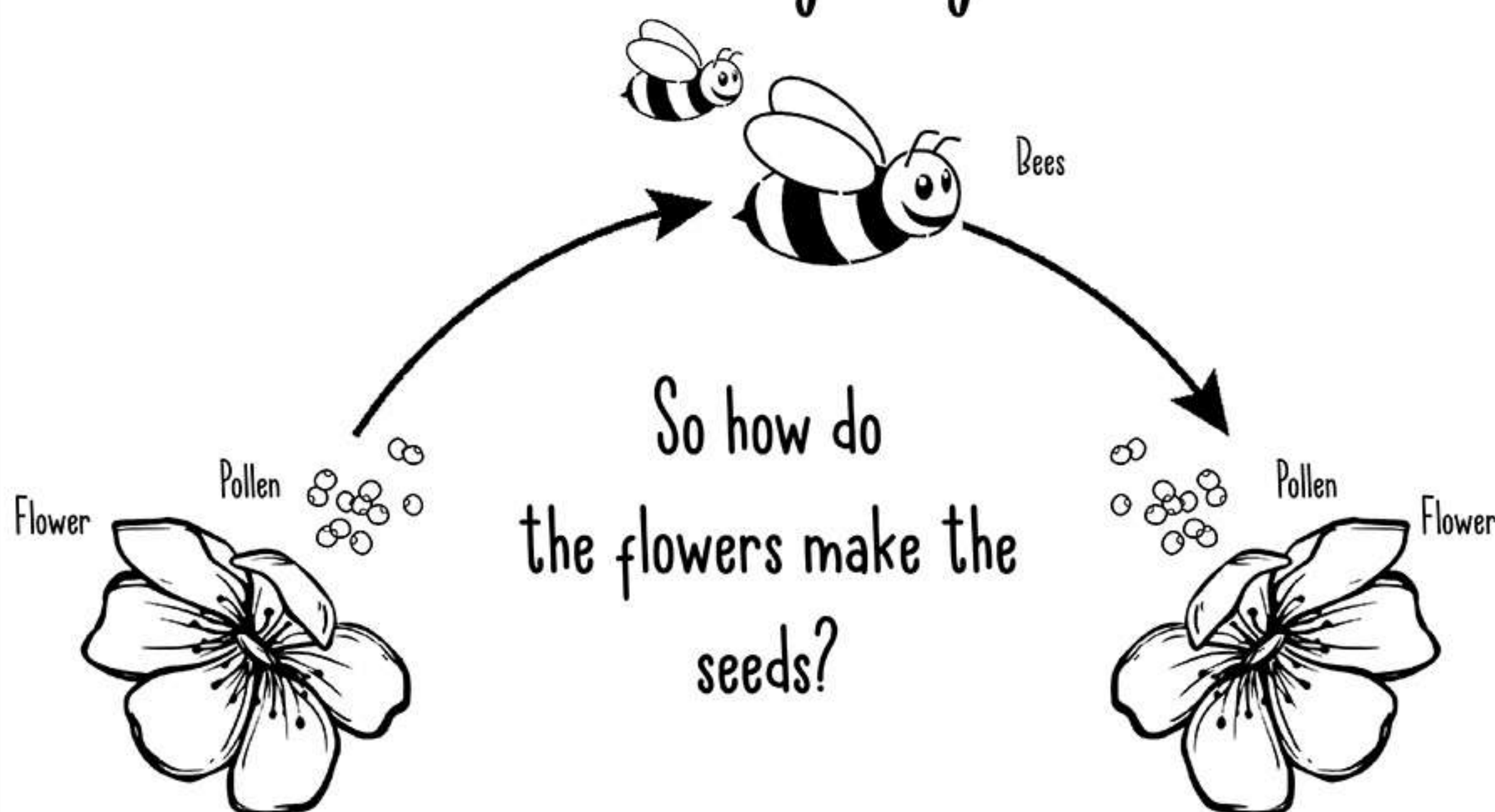
STEP 5

Flowers - Why are they important?



So how does this have anything to do with bees?



Well, one way is by attracting bees. Bees come to the flowers for nectar. As they sit on the flower, the pollen from the flower gets stuck to their legs. The bee buzzes off from there and goes to the next flower. There the pollen on its legs falls off. The process of making seeds begins.

Kartee has created an 8 feet by 4 feet world map in pinewood. It has four clocks on it, depicting four different times in four different cities in the world.

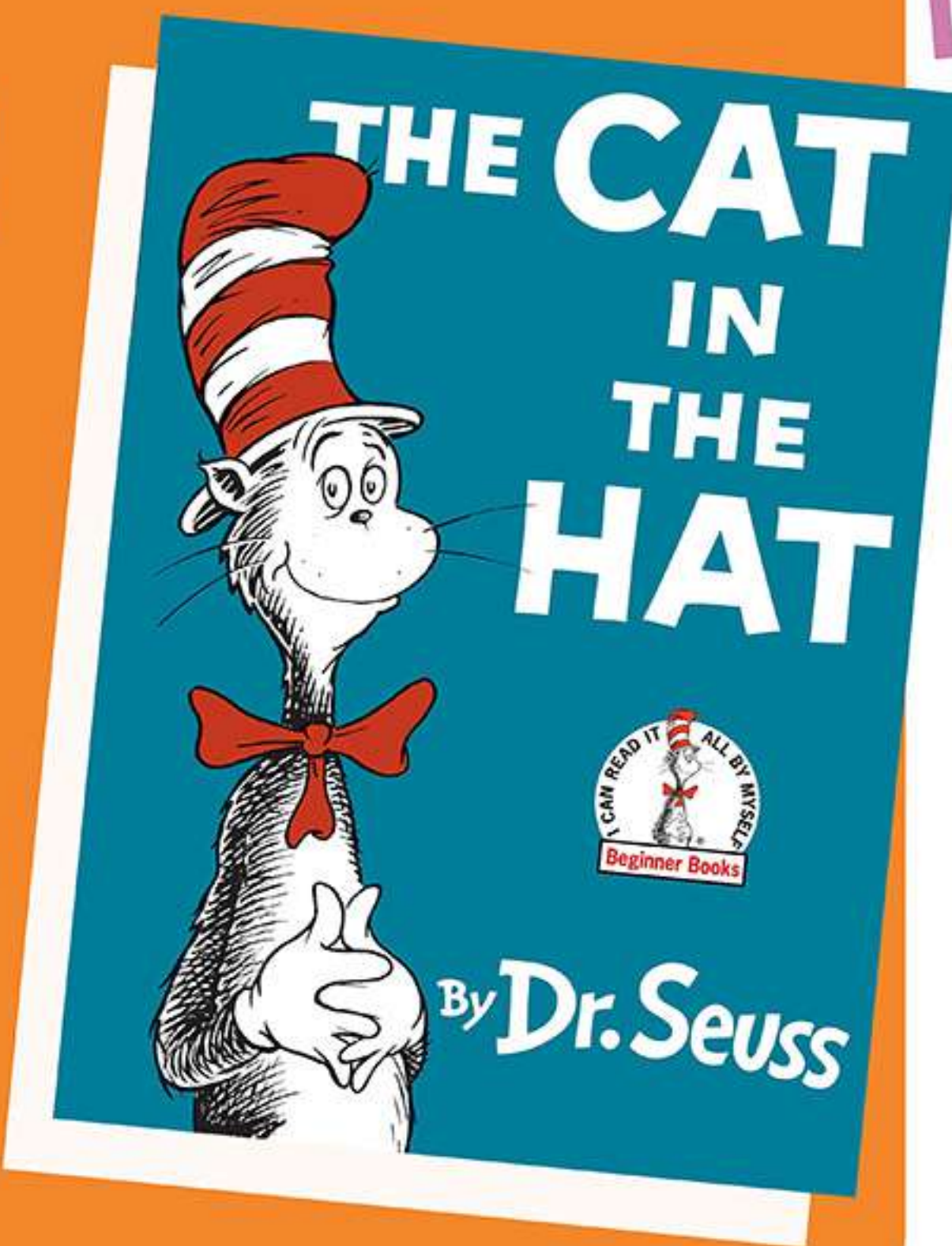
Do you know about time zones? Different parts of the world show different times depending on how far they are from Greenwich (Pronounced as GREN - ICH). Greenwich is a place in London.
